Sandon Fete was established in 1947 by the Royal British Legion; just shortly after the Second World War. As the years past the British Legion decided that it was unable to continue with the fete, due to a reduction in legion members. The remaining organisers felt the demise of the popular event would be a shame, and a significant loss to the village and surrounding area. It was decided to continue the event as an independent fund raiser. In 1998 the Sandon Fete & Transport Show was formed. This was set to continue the popular village event which was now attracting visitors from all over the neighbouring four counties. In the new form the event could now support local and national causes, but also more than one good cause in any one annual event.
